Examination Instructions 2022/2023

- Candidates should ease themselves before entering the examination room. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination room before the end of the examination time.
- 2. Candidates are to be at the examination hall/room/examination confinement room at least 30 minutes prior to starting time ready to be identified and checked.
- 3. No candidate will be allowed in an examination hall/room, confinement room later than 15 minutes after examination session has commenced
- 4. Candidates are obliged to execute immediately all instructions given by an invigilator
- 5. All conversations or any form of communication between candidates must cease once the examination has commenced
- 6. Candidates must not include in any form of examination malpractice i.e. have in their possession any unauthorized materials such as apparatus, books, notes or paper of whatever nature or size, any written symbols or notes on the body parts or clothes e.t.c.
- 7. Mobile phones, recording apparatus and any electronic equipment are prohibited in the examination hall/room/ confinement room
- 8. No candidate may assist or attempt to assist another candidate or obtain assistance or attempt to obtain assistance from candidate with regard to any information during the examination
- 9. Writing on paper other than that supplied for the examination purposes is prohibited.
- 10. Candidates must sit the papers they have registered for; no results will be issued for papers the candidate has not registered for.
- 11. Candidates shall not write on the question papers
- 12. Rough work should be done in the examinations answer book and then crossed out.
- 13. No page (s) shall be removed from the answer booklet(s).
- 14. In NO circumstance(s) must answer booklets, question papers and any other examination materials ,used or unused, be removed by a candidate from the examination room
- 15. Only in exceptional circumstances will a candidate be given permission to leave the examination hall temporarily.
- 16. When the invigilator announces that the time has expired, candidates **must stop writing** immediately otherwise this shall be recorded as examination malpractice
- 17. Candidates are required to attempt each Essay question on a fresh page.
- 18.All Practical papers begin in the morning and may continue to afternoon to take care of shifts of large numbers.
- 19. For All Practical papers, all candidates must be confined at the confinment room by 8,00am
- 20. Please Note: Candidates should report directly to the Board any person(could be another candidate, Invigilator, Tutor, Principal) suspected to be indulging in malpractice through the contacts given above. Any one yielding such information has adequate protection.
- 21. Failure to report any form of suspected Examination malpractice shall be considered a malpractice itself.

Candidates and all concerned must note that, involvement in Examination malpractice may lead to cancellation of results of the whole examination

- 22. All candidates must attend the briefing session; the record of attendance must be kept by the Principal for reference purposes.
- 23. No candidate shall be allowed to sit more than two papers in a session
